More About this Role

Tabling & Outreach Volunteers raise awareness about Compass Center services and provide basic information about domestic violence to the general public through tabling at community events. Volunteers use communication skills to interactively engage diverse groups of participants via multiple modes of engagement. Tabling & Outreach Volunteers:

- Table community events like resource fairs, volunteer fairs, town/county events, etc.
- Facilitate simple interactive activities to encourage attendee participation & engagement
- Address basic questions about domestic violence and Compass Center services
- Skillfully refer survivors who disclose experiences of domestic violence to the hotline
- Provide community members with information about how they can support Compass Center and get involved in our work
- Support community partners with understanding our scope connecting to Compass Center staff
- Share basic event data with Director of Community Education for grant reporting processes
- Support with identifying opportunities for tabling and outreach events

This position is a good fit for individuals who are interested in domestic violence prevention, comfortable and skilled interacting with diverse groups, comfortable and experienced with public speaking and group engagement, excited about engaging community partners, and motivated to learn more about Compass Center services and community resources.

Note: Survivors will sometimes disclose experiences of domestic violence during presentations/tabling events.

Training will include strategies for responding to these disclosures, but if you have concerns about this prior to training please talk with your main staff contact.
